 The 4th community readiness reporting cycle for the below milestone has been completed.

Key highlights



- The trend in National Central Banks confidence levels on the ability of their communities to go-live in November 2021 is overall positive
- 7 NCBs out 25 reported a community status Yellow against 11 in the previous reporting cycle. The remaining NCBs have reported Green No NCB reported Red
- In some markets, the number of CMPs that reported Yellow has slightly increased. In some cases, the change in the confidence of a CMP has impacted the one of a large number of RMPs (e.g. co-management).
- The main reason stated by participants to justify the current status was the lack information on some functionalities → the UDFS v2.1 was published on 20 Dec 2019.
- Our expectation is that the overall confidence should improve in the next reporting cycle.
