Current status



- Following the WS on 08 Oct 2018 on AS settlement procedures, it became apparent, that decommissioning the current ASI settlement procedure 3 is introducing
 - Very high adaptation efforts by the ancillary systems and
 - Complexity in the processing of related messages by market participants
- The ECB project team has registered a change request CSLD-0005-URD “AS settlement procedure based on bilateral settlement”
 - The new procedure will be introduced as an AS settlement procedure E
- The change request aims at re-introducing a settlement process for ancillary systems that is based on bilateral settlement of simultaneously sent debits and credits that shall be processed independently from each other
- Features that were foreseen in URD and UDFS to simplify the replacement of the current AS settlement procedures 2 and 3 by standard payment functionality (i.e. keywords, keyword related additional checks and processes) will be removed

Features of AS settlement procedure E –

- AS can set up a technical account for processing debits and credits
- AS can send one or several AS transfers in a AS batch message (*ASTransferInitiation*). Debits and credits can be
 - Between the RTGS DCAs of the settlement banks of the same AS
 - Check that both accounts belong to the settlement banks of the same AS shall be in place
 - Between RTGS DCA of the AS settlement bank and the technical account of the AS
- All AS transfers are processed
 - Independently from each other
 - With priority Urgent
 - Same processing principles as for payment orders with Urgent priority
- AS can make use of
 - Information period
 - Settlement period (RejectTime)
 - AS transfers not settled by end of the settlement period are rejected by the system
- The CB of the ancillary system can cancel a single AS transfer order from a AS batch message in U2A via GUI, only
 - During the information period
 - During the settlement period as long as the underlying AS transfer is not in a final status
