Committee of Governors of the Central Banks of the Member States of the European Economic Community

1964 - 1993

#### Scope and content

The Committee of Governors fonds mainly consists of meeting documentation, working papers, correspondence, notes and reports, in particular by working groups and task forces. It covers a wide range of contemporary central bank topics, in particular common actions and harmonised procedures in fields such as statistics, payment systems, monetary policy and many others. It reflects the interaction among central banks within and beyond the European Economic Community (EEC) and the cooperation between central banks and national, European and international "players", including, occasionally, the banking industry.

#### **Dates**

The Committee of Governors was active between 1964 and 1993. However, the fonds also covers documentation outside this period dating back to the 1950s, and in one specific case to 1932.

#### Extent of the fonds

The Committee of Governors fonds consists of approximately 51 linear metres of textual documents.

#### Administrative history

Following the signing of the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community (Treaty of Rome) in 1957, first steps towards coordinating monetary policy were taken. The European Commission took the initiative to set up a forum of mainly central bank governors in 1962 after the Dutch and German central banks had conducted a joint monetary intervention which was not coordinated with the other EEC central banks. The European Commission saw a coordinated monetary policy of the Member States mainly as the completion of a common European economic policy.

The Commission suggested setting up a central bank forum located in Brussels and chaired by a member of the Commission. It was difficult to object to the idea of an EEC central bank forum, but the Member State central banks preferred to meet on neutral ground in Switzerland, and the new forum would be closely linked to the Bank for International Settlements (BIS), a non-EEC institution.

The Committee of Governors, which was eventually established by Council Decision 64/300/EEC of 8 May 1964 on cooperation between the Central Banks of the Member States of the EEC, was aimed at holding consultations and exchanging information on monetary policies and relevant measures, with a particular focus on credit and on money and foreign exchange markets.

It was practical for the Committee of Governors to gather in Basel after a BIS meeting, but occasionally they met outside of Basel. In the early years of the Committee, meetings were not very long and did not entail too much additional work for the governors. However, from the end of the 1960s, currency crises required more intense effort and cooperation.

For quite a long time, the Committee only required minimal staff of its own. However, the Committee oversaw a considerable range of activities and expert groups which were staffed mainly by the central banks. Another two professional members of staff below the rank of the Committee's Secretary-General were hired in 1965 and 1973. In the late 1980s, with the expansion of the Committee's activities, more staff were needed.

The first mandate of the Committee of Governors remained in force from 1964 until 1990. In 1990 the Committee's role was strengthened as part of Stage One of Economic and Monetary Union. Its remit was extended to include helping to coordinate monetary and exchange rate policies, which were considered essential for achieving price stability and ensuring the proper functioning of the European Monetary System. An Economic Unit joined the Secretariat, and the Monetary Policy Sub-Committee (MPSC), the Foreign Exchange Policy Sub-Committee (FXPSC) and the Banking Supervision Sub-Committee (BSSC) were established as formal substructures.

In January 1994 the Committee of Governors was replaced by the European Monetary Institute (EMI), and soon afterwards the official seat moved to Frankfurt am Main.

#### **Custodial history**

The documents of the Committee of Governors were stored in Basel at the BIS during the existence of the Committee. After the establishment of the EMI in 1994 and its move Frankfurt am Main later that year, the documentation was transferred to Frankfurt am Main to be integrated into the newly created EMI Archives (later the ECB Archives).

#### Appraisal and destruction

The arrangement and description of the Committee of Governors files required a certain amount of selection and disposal. This procedure was aimed at the destruction of duplicates, ephemeral and administrative documents, copies of legal acts, academic papers and external material not directly related to any activity of the Committee or its substructures, but previously kept as information resources only.

## System of arrangement

The Committee of Governors did not have a comprehensive filing scheme. In addition, many of its activities were rather freewheeling, and, for a while, some expert groups performing these activities were created "ad hoc". In many respects, the quality of filing was dependent on the person in charge of a particular activity and can be rather varied. The current system of arrangement was defined and implemented to finally structure the fonds for historical archives. It is based on the relevant functions and tasks of the former Committee of Governors.

## **Conditions governing access**

Documents of the Committee of Governors are freely accessible, except those relating to the commercial interests of natural and legal persons, including intellectual property, or those whose confidentiality still needs to be protected in the public interest. Furthermore, documents containing sensitive personal data or data relating to the privacy and integrity of individuals are not made available until 100 years after their creation date unless additional safeguards can be applied.

These access conditions are laid down in Articles 4, 5(1), 8(2) and 9 of Decision (EU) 2023/1610 of the European Central Bank of 28 July 2023 establishing the historical archives of the European Central Bank and amending Decision ECB/2004/2 (ECB/2023/17).

#### **Conditions governing reproduction**

Released Committee of Governors documents can be freely reproduced for personal, research or academic use, while for any commercial use the prior authorisation of the ECB is required. Users remain responsible for observing the copyright of third parties.

These conditions are laid down in Article 10 of Decision ECB/2023/17.

#### Languages

The main languages used by Committee of Governors were French, English and, to some extent, German. During the first ten years of its existence, the French language was dominant, which was the custom of many European and international organisations of that period. At the time, French was also the main administrative language in three EEC Member States: France, Belgium and

Luxembourg. Following international trends in the 1970s, and as a consequence of the accession of Ireland and the United Kingdom, English became increasingly important. However, it was not until after March 1975 that English was also used for the agendas of Committee of Governors meetings, and English was not established as one of the languages of the meeting minutes until even later.

The fonds also contains substantial documentation in other EEC Member State languages, and a number of non-EEC languages can also be found.

# Existence and location of copies and originals

The Committee of Governors was a network of national central banks and Community institutions, in particular the European Commission. This means that related documentation can be also found in the archives of central banks within and outside the EU today, in the national archives of Member States and other countries and in the archives of other EU and international institutions.
