





Dear Mr. Honohan,

Pursuant to the Code of Conduct for High-Level ECB Officials I may inform you that I was appointed for the position of the CEO of Oberösterreichische Landesbank AG on January 20^{th} 2020 late afternoon.

Consequently I resigned today from my position as Member of the FMA's Executive Board through an announcement to the Chairman of the FMA's Supervisory Board, the Federal Minister of Finance and the Austrian National Bank. The resignation requires the approval of the FMA's Supervisory Board to become effective which is expected by the end of this week. Therefore I resign from my position as Alternate Member of the Supervisory Board of the SSM with immediate effect.

In order to avoid any potential conflict of interest I immediately started to be on leave the next working day following my application (January 13th 2020) and the FMA's rules of competence were amended accordingly, with the consequence that as of last week my access to sensitive supervisory information within the FMA has been terminated. The Chair of the Supervisory Board of the SSM was informed about these steps on January 14th 2020. From this moment on my access rights to the SSM databases were retracted and I received no further information regarding the SSM.

A possible starting date in this new position could be after a cooling off period of six months. I therefore seek pursuant to Art 17.3 of the Code of Conduct for High-Level ECB Officials the Ethics Committee's advice if such period is adequate.

Dear President Lagarde, dear Prof. Honohan,

I am writing to seek the non-objection of the Governing Council of the European Central Bank regarding post-employment activities as envisioned in Article 17 of the Code of Conduct for high-level ECB officials. My membership of the Governing Council of the ECB ended on 7 June 2019.

I have now received offers for part-time employment from two Estonian universities.

entailing a combination of academic or public lecturing, research and possibly supervision of graduate students.

Alongside this part-time employment, I would also like to pursue some project-based consulting work for official bodies (governments, central banks, etc) through the various international organisations which usually conduct such work (e.g. International Monetary Fund, World Bank Group, European Commission, Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development, etc). This could involve economic analysis (including report writing) or technical assistance.

More concretely, I was recently approached by the regarding my availability to help finalize the Public Expenditure Review. This is an opportunity I wish to seriously consider. Most of the background analysis for this report is being completed and my envisaged role would be to help synthesize inputs of various experts into a coherent overall report. Initial expectations are for this to involve 2-3 weeks of work during March and April 2020.

Such opportunities are always time-limited but can arise suddenly and require a quick response. For this reason, I would seek your pre-approval for agreeing to similar consulting engagements for the remainder of my 2-year notification period. These would always involve working for public sector bodies through renowned international organisations. I would, of course, report all such work in my annual declaration of gainful occupational activities and remuneration received during the 2-year notification period.

Were I to receive offers to consult for private sector entities, I would, of course, seek your separate and explicit approval.


