Terms and conditions of the #EUROat20 ECB-QuizClash competition

The European Central Bank (ECB), supported by [MAG Interactive AB](#), is organising a quiz-based competition on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of the euro. The competition, “#EUROat20 ECB-QuizClash”, will run from 10:00 CET on 18 February 2019 until 23:59 CET on 10 March 2019.

Entry is open to anyone residing in the European Union (EU)¹ and eligible to register using the QuizClash app² [[link](#)].

To play the quiz and enter the competition, players should take note of the following steps:

1. Download the QuizClash mobile app and create an account (with your username, email address and password);
2. Play the entire “#EUROat20” quiz featured on the start page of the application;
3. After the competition closing date (10 March 2019), a draw will take place in which 30 winners are selected from among those entrants who correctly answered all 18 quiz questions;
4. The winners will receive a push notification inside the QuizClash app requesting the submission of an email to MAG Interactive AB for receiving the prize. To receive the push notification, please ensure the push notification feature is enabled both in the app and on your mobile device;
5. As of the moment the notification is sent, the winners will have ten working days to send an email to the contact email address to prove their eligibility and claim their prize. They will also have to read and accept these terms and conditions, as well as the terms and conditions relating to the processing of personal data;
6. After verification of the winners’ eligibility, each winner will be invited to choose between the two prizes on offer: a one-month continuous Interrail Global Pass or an iPad Pro (10.5”, 64GB). The prizes will be awarded by the ECB;
7. Winners will only be entitled to one prize;
8. Employees and staff of the European System of Central Banks (ESCB) and of MAG Interactive AB – or their close relatives (spouses, partners, parents, children or siblings) – may not enter the competition;

¹ The countries of the European Union are Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

² Under MAG Interactive AB’s Terms of Service, the following minimum age requirements, which differ according to country of origin, apply to persons intending to play the company’s games or use its services: 16 years – France, Germany, Hungary, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Slovakia; 15 years – Finland; 14 years – Austria; 13 years – all other countries.

Any registration deemed not in line with these terms and conditions will result in the disqualification of the individual concerned.

Data protection

1. Data protection legal framework applicable to the ECB

All personal data provided by participants will be processed in accordance with EU Data Protection Law³.

2. What personal data will we process?

The ECB will process the data that the winners provided in the registration form, such as username and email address, as well as any further information required for delivery of the chosen prize (i.e. first name, surname, date of birth, address and, if a winner chooses the Interrail Global Pass, nationality and passport or ID card number).

3. Who is responsible for processing your personal data?

The ECB is the data controller and the ECB's Directorate General Communications is responsible for processing your personal data.

The competition is hosted by the Swedish external provider MAG Interactive AB, which processes the data collected via the QuizClash mobile app.

4. Why are we processing your personal data and what is the legal basis for their processing?

All personal data is collected and processed based on the participants' consent for the purpose of managing the competition, such as contacting and providing the participants with relevant information, awarding the prizes and publishing the first names and surnames, or usernames, of the winners on the website(s) of the ECB and/or national central banks of the ESCB and/or other EU institutions, as well as on social media channels such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and LinkedIn.

By providing the personal data requested, participants consent to the aforementioned processing. Participants can withdraw their consent at any time by contacting the ECB's Directorate General Communications at ecbyouthinitiatives@ecb.europa.eu. Future processing of their personal information will stop once they have withdrawn their consent, but prior processing will remain lawful.

5. Who will receive your personal data?

The personal data that participants provide in the registration form will be disclosed to the following recipients:

- Dedicated employees of the ECB's Directorate General Communications, who are managing the competition;
- Dedicated employees of the German travel provider Westtours-Reisen GmbH, who will be processing the data of those winners choosing the Interrail Global Pass as their prize, under instructions from and on behalf of the ECB.

The first name and surnames, or usernames, of the winners published on the ECB's website and social media channels will be accessible to the general public.

6. How long will we keep your data?

³ Regulation (EU) [2018/1725](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC.

Personal data will be stored by the ECB for three (3) months, starting from the date of submission of the personal data. After the three-month period has expired the data will be deleted.

Personal data published on the ECB's website or social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter or LinkedIn) will be retained as long as the relevant websites/social media indicate in their privacy statement.

7. Your Rights

You have the right to access, correct and (with some limitations) request erasure or restriction of the processing of your personal data in line with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725. You can exercise your rights by emailing the ECB's Directorate General Communications at ecbyouthinitiatives@ecb.europa.eu.

You have the right of recourse to the [European Data Protection Supervisor \(EDPS\)](#) at any time regarding the processing of your personal data.

Cancellation, applicable law

The ECB and MAG Interactive AB reserve the right to cancel all or part of the competition at any time.

This competition will be governed by German law. All cases not specifically provided for under these terms and conditions will be decided on by the ECB and its decisions will be considered final. Any claims must be submitted within two months of the closing date of the competition.
