In anticipation of future activities related to communication projects and campaigns, the ECB intends to award several framework agreements for the provision of external professional services in communication

management services. The selected companies and their representatives will contribute to the successful completion of various projects and campaigns at European level.

One of these projects and also the most important one is the development of the 2nd series of euro banknotes by the ECB and the national central banks (NCBs) of the Eurosystem.

The current plan of the euro banknotes and coins project is to introduce the 1st denomination of the 2nd series in the next few years and to inform the public about it via a communication campaign.

Important: For such a project, the ECB must separate clearly the activities related to the conception and project management of a potential ES2 campaign from its implementation (possible scope of activities was highlighted above).
