<p>4</p>	<p>Regarding Section IV 1.1, could you please confirm that interested parties who are invited to participate in the tender will be notified via email, not via the internet platform?</p>	<p>We could confirm that interested parties who are invited to participate in the tender will be notified via e-mail and not via the internet platform. Nevertheless, the status of the Call to express interest for participating (i.e. 'ongoing'/'pending selection decision'/'closed') is available on the ECB's website (http://www.ecb.europa.eu/ecb/jobsproc/tenders/html/index.en.html) and interested parties shall regularly check the status.</p>
<p>5</p>	<p>Could you confirm that when you refer to "subcontractors" you are only referring to partner schools which would provide language training services and not freelance trainers?</p>	<p>For the purposes of procurement procedures, subcontractors are defined as separate legal entities on which tenderers intend to rely to provide the services.</p> <p>However, for the purposes of the current selection phase (Call to express interest for participating), interested parties are only required</p>

		<p>to list those subcontractors on whose capacities the interested party intends to rely to meet the selection criteria (please refer to Response form, Annex 2 to CEP, § 2.4).</p> <p>If invited to participate in the tender, interest parties will be allowed to declare further subcontractors during that phase (Five-quote procedure).</p>
<p>6</p>	<p>Regarding the "subcontractors" section, would you require us to provide information solely regarding any subcontractors that would be required to carry out extensive language courses or for ALL subcontractors who may be required to carry out the services.</p> <p>Without having exact details of, for example, in which European cities intensive courses would be carried out, it would be difficult to provide a complete list of which partner schools we might need to use.</p>	<p>For the purposes of the current selection phase (Call to express interest for participating), interested parties are only required to list those subcontractors on whose capacities the interest party intends to rely to meet the selection criteria (please refer to Response form, Annex 2 to CEP, § 2.4).</p> <p>If invited to participate in the tender, interest parties will be allowed to declare further subcontractors during that phase (Five-quote procedure).</p>
<p>7</p>	<p>Financial eligibility</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Does turnover mean earnings? ii. Does EUR 1.200.000 mean EUR 1.2 million or EUR 1,200.00 €? iii. Does the accumulated total net turnover of the interested party need to be EUR 1.200.000 in each of the three financial years or a combined total of EUR 1.200.000 for the three financial years? 	<p>In relation to the financial capacity (minimum requirement as referred to in the CEP, Section III, § 4.2, p. 7), please note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Differently from earnings, the "accumulated total net turnover" selection criterion within the meaning of the CEP, Section III, § 4.2, p. 7, means the "gross profit" (sales revenues minus the cost of goods/services sold); ii. EUR 1.200.000 means EUR 1,2 million (one million two hundred thousand EUR); iii. The accumulated total net turnover of the interested party need to be a combined total of EUR 1.200.000 over the last three financial years (2014-2016) and not in each of the three financial years.
