

First network service providers pass TIPS compliance check

TARGET Instant Payment Settlement (TIPS) will be launched on 30 November 2018 as a network-agnostic service. This means that the providers that have been proposed by TIPS participants and that have shown they meet the specified [connectivity requirements](#) can offer connectivity services for TIPS.

The following network service providers have successfully completed the compliance check and are ready to offer connectivity services to TIPS users:

- SIA
- SWIFT

The compliance check includes a series of tests to verify that the providers are able to deliver the required technical infrastructure and software components for exchanging messages between TIPS and its users in a secure and reliable manner.

Disclaimer: All network service providers that have successfully passed the compliance check and signed the hosting terms and conditions for TIPS connectivity will be added to a list of TIPS network service providers, published on the ECB's website. TIPS participants shall monitor whether their chosen provider continues to offer an active connection to TIPS.
