Current Status

Current Status



Reaching the Key Milestones

- Completion of CSLD.NCO2: all participants should have completed their connectivity to the T2 Test Environment
- Completion of CSLD.IST2: all participants should have completed their training for the User Testing activities.
- Start of CSLD.UTA1: Participants will also have commenced User Testing.

User Testing began on 1 December

- NCBs are now performing the pre-migration in the test environment and inserting the reference data from the Registration form.
- This allows us to prepare for the production pre-migration.



User Testing Organisation

User Testing

- User Testing is a stage in the development of the system which allows the users to test in an environment as close to production as possible.
- User Testing is split into three phases:



User Testing



Throughout these stages the participants can test the system end to end with the support of the Eurosystem (at first instance their National Central Bank).

- Migration Testing (Both Pre-migration and migration)
- Operational Testing (Operational related tests)
- Co-ordinated Testing (Billing, Ancillary Systems)
- Volume Testing (on request)
- Mandatory Test Cases
- Business Day Testing

Registration

Registration

Participants have already registered for the test environment by filling in the Registration form.



The Registration and onboarding Guide contains a description of every reference data field in the Common Reference Data Module and explains the configuration that can be done by the participants after they have been registered in the system.

- The Eurosystem will provide an updated version of the Registration form and a new version of the Registration and Onboarding guide for Production.
- Participants are asked to pay close attention to the guide and to contact your national service desk for any questions.




Migration Testing

Migration Testing


During the User Testing period the Eurosystem will rehearse the activities of the go-live in a set of rehearsals.

The reference data set-up activities will be rehearsed in a series of tests known as the **Pre-Migration** rehearsals. The activities related to the go-live date including the cutover from TARGET2 to T2 and the connection of the other TARGET Services will be tested in the **Migration** rehearsals. The **assistance** of the T2 Participants will be required in some cases and your National Central Bank will co-ordinate the activities.



Description	T2 participant user will verify that the liquidity transfers have settled in T2. If a T2 participant identifies an incorrect balance, the T2 participant must verify that the instruction was correctly executed. If there is an issue that is preventing the T2 participant from reconciling the balance, the T2 participant should report this to its National Service Desk in order to identify the root cause and to remedy the error. This activity is optional, i.e. only required if the T2 participant has initiate immediate liquidity transfers.



Testing Campaigns

Testing campaigns

During the **User Testing Period** the Eurosystem will organise specific **testing campaigns**:



Volume Testing – for participants who wish to send and receive a large amount of traffic from the system.



Ancillary Systems – ensuring that the ancillary systems are able to test their use cases under production-like conditions.



Billing – ensuring that all billable items are created and reflected accurately in the invoice and ensuring that all invoices are correctly delivered.

Billing Testing Campaign



One week billing period:

- All billable items will be booked
- All applicable charges will be confirmed
- Manual corrections will be performed by the NCBS
- Invoice from Camt.077 or in PDF format

The Eurosystem will share a **dedicated document** which will include the dates.

Ancillary System Testing Campaign



Dedicated testing period from 11-29 July 2022

- All Ancillary Systems will be requested to take part.
- All of the procedures will be tested.
- Dedicated document to be released.



- Time to prepare as the **procedures run every day** in the test environment.
- Procedures can also be tested post campaign but this period will be the most production-like due to high participation.

Volume Testing

 Participants may request a window from the Eurosystem in which they can send large volumes of payment instructions to the test environment.

Procedure:

- The system will generate large volume of responses which participants can then integrate into their system.
- After the request is made, the Eurosystem will confer and provide the requester with the slot.
- **Objective**: testing the participants' ability to manage a large volume of responses from the system. This is not volume testing of the T2 system (which is carried-out by the service provider)

Business Day Testing

The synchronised standard day is the specific test schedule for the T2
Test environment. It allows for an earlier change of business date to
assist testing.



- During Business Day Testing the test environment will follow the schedule of the Production T2 environment. This allows for the testing of integrated systems in preparation for Production.
- The timing of this test period has not yet been confirmed, NCBs will inform the communities.



Mandatory Test Cases

Mandatory Test Cases

The Eurosystem has devised a set of Mandatory Test Cases for participants



Participants are asked to perform these tests successfully and to submit the
evidence to their National Central Bank. Successful performance of these tests
is mandatory in order to be allowed to go-live in Production.



• The Eurosystem will provide a dedicated slot in the **Testing Calendar** for performance of these tests. Participants are advised not to leave it too late.




 This is <u>not</u> an exhaustive set of test cases and in some cases the National Central Banks have <u>added further authorisation test cases</u> to the test suite.

Upcoming Milestones



- Participants will commence their connectivity testing to production on 1 May 2022 (CSLD.NCP01).
- Connectivity to production must be proven before 31 July 2022 (CSLD.NCP02).
- The Pre-Migration in production commences on 22 August 2022 (CSLD.MIG1).
