

# TIPS Community Readiness Report Status as of Q3 2021 (cut-off date 30/07/21)

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### **Executive Summary**

This Readiness Report depicts the status of all NCBs communities<sup>1</sup> (i.e. PSPs and ACHs subject to the TIPS Pan-European Reachability Measures) as of 30 July 2021.

In line with the introduction of different milestone dates by wave and the timeline of the key milestones for the ACHs to ensure a successful and timely migration to TIPS, the following current and past milestones cover both uncompleted and due milestones related to this reporting round<sup>2</sup>:

- TIPS.NSP3.ACH NSP selection and contract preparation completed 31/03/2021
- TIPS.NSP4.ACH NSP procurement completed 31/03/2021
- TIPS.IAD4.ACH Drafting of internal applications documentation completed 28/05/2021
- TIPS.IAD5.ACH Software development for the required internal system adaptations started -01/06/2021
- TIPS.IAD7.ACH Testing of the internal applications started 01/07/2021
- TIPS.NCO1.ACH Network connectivity tests on testing environment started 01/06/2021
- TIPS.NCO2.WA1.ACH Network connectivity tests on testing environment completed for ACHs of the Wave 1 - 30/06/2021
- TIPS.IST2.WA1.ACH Internal staff training completed for ACHs of the Wave 1- 30/07/2021

#### 1. PSP Community readiness to migrate to TIPS


### Confidence level reported by NCBs

The overall confidence level reported by the NCBs for their PSP communities subject to this reporting is significantly good. From a total of 15 NCBs, 10 reported a green status for their PSP communities, 4 NCBs reported a yellow status and one NCB has not yet reported any status.

The overall confidence level of this 4<sup>th</sup> reporting cycle is slightly decreasing. The confidence level reported by 1 NCB has decreased in comparison with the previous reporting cycle. One NCB has downgraded their overall confidence level from Green to Yellow since one Direct Participant has changed its confidence level from Green to Yellow and another one has changed it from Yellow to Red due to dependencies on their IT suppliers and other internal priorities.

### Confidence level reported by the TIPS Direct Participants and Reachable Parties<sup>3</sup>

### TIPS Direct Participants confidence level:

A very good response ratio was observed during this fourth readiness reporting exercise: out of 112 TIPS Direct participants, only 2 (2%) did not report their readiness status.

The overall confidence level of the TIPS Direct Participants remains positive and in line with the previous reporting: 74 out of 112 (66%) have reported a green status, 30 (27%) have indicated a yellow level of confidence and 6 (5%) have reported a red status.

In this reporting cycle, we could see a slight decrease in the total number of Direct Participants reporting their readiness: 112 TIPS Direct Participants have reported their readiness during this reporting cycle instead of 120 in the previous reporting cycle. Some NCBs have reported that some of their Direct Participants have already joined TIPS, that they have decided to become reachable via another Participant or that they no longer aim at becoming SCT Inst scheme compliant this year. These variations remain limited.

### TIPS Reachable Parties confidence level:

All Reachable Parties subject to this reporting have reported their readiness status.

In this reporting cycle, we could see a slight increase in the total number of Reachable Parties reporting their readiness: 2121 TIPS Reachable Parties have reported their readiness during this reporting cycle instead of 2118 in the previous reporting cycle. Some NCBs have reported additional Reachable Parties joining while some others reported a decrease in these numbers, these variations remain limited.




While 18% of Reachable Parties (376) have reported a green status, respectively 25% (533) and 57% (1212) out of the 2121 TIPS Reachable Parties have reported a yellow and a red status. The latter are mainly concentrated with one Direct Participant.

The main issues and concerns encountered by the PSP communities are as follows:

- Tight project timeline.
- Dependencies with external providers (e.g. Software vendors, NSPs...) and other priorities.
- High concentration of activities towards the end of the project deadline, leaving little buffer in case of slippage.
- Some PSPs have open questions on TIPS functionalities, related CRs and supporting documentation which can impact their project preparation timeline.
- Potential resource constraints due to parallelism of internal initiatives.
- [For Reachable Parties]: Concentration risk as many Reachable Parties rely on the readiness of one specific institution to on-board to TIPS.

These issues are in the process of been mitigated and should not impact the ability of these PSPs to reach the agreed deadline for on-boarding.

#### PSPs readiness per key phase

With respect to the overall readiness of the PSPs by key phase of the project, the following table highlights the fact that most of the PSPs (1853, i.e. 83%) are still in the preparation phase and 17% (377) have completed that phase.

In comparison with the previous reporting cycle, we could see that many PSPs progressed in their projects and that 87% of the PSPs (most of them are Reachable Parties) started the subsequent

Implementation phase. The number of PSPs having also started the remaining Testing and On-boarding phases (On-going status) has sharply increased from around 3% towards respectively 21% (490) and 20% (460), mainly due to progress made by some Reachable Parties.


### 2. ACH Community readiness to migrate to TIPS


#### Confidence level

All ACHs subject to the TIPS reachability measures have provided information on their readiness status to migrate to TIPS except one that has not yet reported any status.

The overall confidence level reported by the ACHs is good and "Green" confidence level has been reported for 7 ACH as it was the case in the previous reporting cycle.

From a total of 11 ACHs, 7 (64%) have reported a green status, 3 (27%) have stated a yellow status and 1 ACH (9%) has not yet reported any status

Confidence level reported by 2 ACHs during this reporting cycle has improved from a Yellow status to a Green status: the introduction of specific milestone dates for ACHs involved in Wave 3 and the derogation received from the Governing council of the ECB to settle both SCT and SCT Inst transactions over TIPS technical account have increased the confidence level to migrate to TIPS on time.

Confidence level reported one ACH during this reporting cycle has decreased from a Green status to a Yellow status. According to this ACH, the Detailed Migration Document has not yet been published and that the TIPS registration guide has not yet been updated, leading to some confusions regarding the registration process.

The main issues and concerns highlighted by the ACHs in their reporting are as follows:


- Lack of visibility on the operational processes and contractual aspects
- Missing documentation / information from the Eurosystem and from external parties
- Dependencies with other internal projects
- Different internal timeline for a milestone.

The documentation part is currently still under investigation.

### Milestone completion

Regarding milestones completion, the current milestones for the ACHs were significantly met as presented in the below chart<sup>4</sup>:

As highlighted in the diagram above, we can see that most of the ACHs involved in wave 1, except one, are experiencing delays on the completion of the milestone IST2 (Internal staff training completed).

Most of these ACHs involved in wave 1 follow a different internal timeline for the completion of IST2 milestone. Milestone completion is currently ongoing, but delays have arisen, mainly due to:

- Missing documentation / information from the Eurosystem and external parties,
- Dependencies with internal projects

The documentation part is currently still under investigation.

Delays for the completion of the milestone IAD7 (Testing of the internal applications started) remain limited since 2 ACHs should be able to complete this milestone by August 15<sup>th</sup>. One of these 2 ACHs follows a different internal timeline for the completion of this milestone but milestone completion is ongoing.

The overall trend reported by NCBs whose ACH is involved in wave 1 remains positive but 4 NCBs currently report a yellow confidence status regarding the completion of the upcoming milestone IAD8.

The overall trend reported by the 4 NCBs whose ACH is involved in wave 3 is significantly positive and these 4 NCBs currently report a green status regarding the completion of the upcoming milestones.

4 ACHs also currently report a yellow confidence level for the completion of the milestone UTA1.

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The overall level of confidence reported by the Direct Participants is slightly decreasing while the one reported by the Reachable Parties remains stable. The overall level of confidence reported by the ACHs is increasing.

Here below is presented the overall level of confidence reported by the PSPs and ACH communities.
