EURO AREA SECURITIES ISSUES STATISTICS: DECEMBER 2008

The annual growth rate of the outstanding amount of debt securities issued by euro area residents increased from 8.1% in November 2008 to 9.4% in December. For the outstanding amount of quoted shares issued by euro area residents, the annual growth rate was 1.0% in December 2008, compared with 0.9% in November.

New issuance of <u>debt securities</u> by euro area residents totalled EUR 1,505 billion in December 2008 (see Table I and Chart I). As redemptions came to EUR 1,373 billion, net issues amounted to EUR 133 billion (see Table I). The annual growth rate of outstanding debt securities issued by euro area residents increased from 8.1% in November 2008 to 9.4% in December (see Table I and Chart 3).

As regards the sectoral breakdown, the annual growth rate of outstanding debt securities issued by non-financial corporations increased from 3.8% in November 2008 to 6.6% in December (see Table 2 and Chart 4). For the monetary financial institutions sector (MFI sector), this growth rate was 5.5% in December 2008, compared with 5.6% in November. The annual growth rate of outstanding debt securities issued by financial corporations other than MFIs increased from 24.7% in November 2008 to 28.3% in December. For the general government, this growth rate increased from 6.5% in November 2008 to 8.0% in December.

As regards the maturity breakdown, the annual growth rate of outstanding short-term debt securities increased from 23.2% in November 2008 to 27.7% in December (see Table I and Chart 3). The annual growth rate of outstanding short-term debt securities issued by MFIs decreased from 12.3% to 10.9% during the same period (see Table 2). For long-term debt securities, the annual growth rate increased from 6.3% in November 2008 to 7.2% in December. The annual growth rate of outstanding long-term debt securities issued by MFIs increased from 4.4% to 4.5% during the same period. The annual growth rate of outstanding fixed rate long-term debt securities increased from 3.3% in November 2008 to 4.0% in December. The annual growth rate of outstanding variable rate long-term debt securities increased from 13.7% in November 2008 to 15.5% in December. Net issuance of variable rate debt securities increased to EUR 128.5 billion in December 2008, from EUR 81.0 billion in November; a large part of this increase can be attributed to gross issuance by financial corporations other than MFIs.

Concerning the currency breakdown, the annual growth rate of outstanding euro-denominated debt securities increased from 8.9% in November 2008 to 10.3% in December. Net issuance of euro-denominated debt securities totalled EUR 147.1 billion in December 2008, thus largely exceeding the average level of transactions during the year, which was EUR 92.1 billion. For debt securities in other currencies, this growth rate increased from 2.1% in November 2008 to 2.3% in December (see Table 1).

The seasonally adjusted three-month annualised growth rate of outstanding debt securities issued by euro area residents increased from 9.3% in November 2008 to 18.9% in December (see Table 3 and Chart 5).

New issuance of <u>quoted shares</u> by euro area residents totalled EUR 9.3 billion in December 2008 (see Table 4). As redemptions came to EUR 2.5 billion, net issues amounted to EUR 6.9 billion. The annual growth rate of the outstanding amount of quoted shares issued by euro area residents (excluding valuation changes) was 1.0% in December 2008, compared with 0.9% in November (see Table 4 and Chart 6). The annual growth rate of quoted shares issued by non-financial corporations was 0.0% in December 2008, compared with -0.1% in November. For monetary financial institutions, it was 5.8% in December 2008, compared with 5.9% in November. For financial corporations other than MFIs, this growth rate increased from 2.3% in November 2008 to 3.0% in December.

The outstanding amount of quoted shares issued by euro area residents totalled EUR 3,474 billion at the end of December 2008. Compared with EUR 6,579 billion at the end of December 2007, this represents an annual decrease of 47.2% in the value of the stock of quoted shares in December 2008, compared with an annual decrease of 47.5% in November, mainly due to market valuation changes

Unless otherwise indicated, all euro area aggregates refer to the euro area 15 (the euro area excluding Slovakia) for the whole time series. Data for Slovakia will be included for the first time in the release referring to January 2009 statistics (to be published on 16 March 2009). In addition to the developments for December 2008, this press release incorporates minor revisions to the data for previous periods. A complete set of updated securities issues statistics is available on the "Money, banking and financial markets" pages of the "Statistics" section of the ECB's website (http://www.ecb.int/stats/money/securities/html/index.en.html). These data, as well as euro area data in accordance with the composition of the euro area at the time of the reference period, can be downloaded using the ECB's Statistical Data Warehouse (SDW).

Data for the period up to December 2008 will also be published in the March 2009 issues of the ECB's Monthly Bulletin and Statistics Pocket Book. The next press release on euro area securities issues will be published on 16 March 2009.


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Chart 1: Total gross issuance of debt securities by euro area residents

(EUR billions; transactions during the month; nominal values; seasonally adjusted)





Chart 3: Annual growth rates of debt securities issued by euro area residents, by original maturity (percentage changes)

Chart 4: Annual growth rates of debt securities issued by euro area residents, by sector $(percentage\ changes)$






Chart 5: Growth rates of debt securities issued by euro area residents, seasonally adjusted (percentage changes)


