General comments

Banks need to report on number of ATM's, as well as the value and number of withdrawals at these ATMs. To get a better and more complete picture of all ATM's in a country, it would be just to also request all Independent ATM Deployers (IADs) to report statistics on number of ATMs they operate, as well as the value and number of withdrawals at these ATMs. Could you please consider to include reporting by IAD's in the Reporting Regulation as well as data on the geographical location of these ATM's in order to assess the access to cash. Due to the different market settings in each country, NCBs should take care to include also the the value and number of withdrawals at ATMs of Independent ATM Deployers (IADs) and their locations by country. This can be done directly, if PSD2 regulated, or indirectly via the respective acquirer
